

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Students are admitted to certificate, master's degree, and doctoral degree programs throughout the year. Students are encouraged to apply as soon as possible to facilitate a timely and successful entry into their FISC program. Applications are requested two months before the start date of the first intended course.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

Prerequisites: In advancement of enrollment, the following degrees will be completed:

- A bachelor's degree or its equivalency is required for the certificate and master's degree programs, and for auditing intensives. An equivalency consists of documented training beyond a high school degree that is equivalent in hours and requirements to a bachelor's degree.
- A master's degree is required for doctoral degree programs.

To Apply:

Complete the Admission Application form on-line, and follow the outlined steps below. Please send all the documents together, with the exception of the transcripts that need to come directly from the institution that granted the degrees.

Application Components:

1. Complete Admission Application form on-line
2. Official (sealed) transcripts in English showing completion and conferral of your B.A. degree (and Master's degree for the Doctoral Degree programs). Transcripts from the Office of the Registrar of previous institutions you have attended must be sent directly to the FICS Office of Admissions.
3. A resume showing your academic endeavors, work experiences, and creative projects.
4. Two current letters of recommendation.
We recommend you invite one professional reference and one personal reference to assess your readiness for graduate studies based on their knowledge of:
 - 1) Your ability and desire to study.
 - 2) Your hope to apply your new studies to your current work.
 - 3) Your chances for success in a highly intense and often self-initiated certificate or degree program.

5. Statement of Interest
 - a. Certificate and Master's degree (1,500 words)
 - i. Describes how you intend to integrate studies in Creation Spirituality with transformative work in the world. Please prepare a focused assessment of your readiness for advanced study that articulates personal insights and intentions in relation to entering this program.
 - b. Doctoral degree (2,000 words)
 - i. Describe how you intend to integrate studies in Creation Spirituality with transformative work in the world. Also include a discussion of your academic research interests. Please prepare a focused assessment of your readiness for advanced study that articulates personal insights and intentions in relation to entering this program.
6. Non-refundable application fee of \$100 for Certificate, Master's and Doctoral Degrees.
7. Non-refundable application fee of \$35 for Auditors.

Auditors

Auditors can omit steps 2-4. For step 5, please include a Statement of Interest regarding the intensive you wish to audit.

ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students are a valued part of the FICS community and are encouraged to apply if they are allowed to study in the United States without visas.

FICS is not able to accept degree seeking students on foreign visas at this time. This status will be reevaluated in 2019.

MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMS

FICS offers seven different Master's Degrees:

- Master of Spirituality and Intergenerational Wisdom
- Master of Spirituality and Sacred Activism
- Master of Spirituality and Ecological Justice
- Master of Spirituality and Gender Perspectives
- Master of Spirituality and Spiritual Direction

The Master's degree programs entail fourteen, five-day-long intensives that are to be completed within a period of five years from initiation of study, an oral Candidate Review, and a Master's thesis or Practicum depending upon the specific program.

DOCTORAL PROGRAMS

Fox Institute offers two Doctoral Degree options: The Doctor of Ministry and the Doctor of Spirituality.

The Doctoral Degree programs entail ten, five-day-long intensives that are to be completed within a period of five years from initiation of study, an oral Candidate Review, and a Doctor of Ministry Project or Doctoral Dissertation and defense depending upon the specific program.
